DIRECTIONS TO THE PARK:

From U.S. 42, take KY HWY 1992. Follow HWY 1992 until the pavement ends. Keep going straight onto the gravel lane. The gravel lane leads directly into Hartig Park and Nature Preserve.

Hartig Park and Wildlife Reserve is Gallatin County's newest public park. Comprising over 500 acres, these former working farms are now an outdoor lovers dream!

Located at the northeastern tip of Gallatin County, this natural wonder boasts miles of walking & hiking trails, picnic areas, canoe & kayak access to nearby creeks, and spots for primitive camping. Hartig Park is also suitable for mountain biking and horseback riding.

Future projects, should funding become available, include permanent restroom facilities, handicapped accessible canoe and kayak launch, and a potable water source for people and animals.
